THANKS

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

SECURITY

The Edisto Beach police department reported four minor incidences in the last month which included potential damage to the golf course, a fire extinguisher thrown into the Summerwinds pond, a mail box knocked over, and a theft of unidentified items from under a home. Earlier this year, we had an under-aged driver in a golf cart damage the Jenkins security gate. This was recorded on camera, and the property owner has paid for the repair.

We want to remind everyone that only Ocean Ridge owners are permitted to bring boats and/or golf carts into Ocean Ridge, and they must have Ocean Ridge permits. If you do not have a permit, please contact Horace Kinsey.

ROADS

The board approved a motion to begin the process of exploring costs for resurfacing Sea Cloud Circle and a section of King Cotton Road. We hope to complete this project if bids are within budget late 2014 or first quarter 2015.

Major pothole repairs will be completed in the near future.

LAGOONS

The board approved the addition of tilapia to the lagoons to help control algae.

BEAUTIFICATION

The island beautification project on the boulevard area King Cotton Road by the golf course has been completed and, it looks great. The deer are feeding on it, but they have not caused serious damage. Plans are being made to begin a beautification project on the Jenkins gate entrance.

FINANCE

Finances continue to be in good shape. Revenue income is approximately \$2,000 over budget, and we continue to reduce late payments. Thanks for paying your regime fees on time. Expenses are under budget due to no major projects in the first quarter. Maintenance of the Summerwinds gate, Jenkins gate entrance improvement, and the lagoon tilapia fish costs will add to our expenses next quarter. Our total reserve equity is over \$400,000. A major portion of this reserve will be used on the road resurfacing projects.
